Hudsonville — The Hudsonville Friends of Transit and Lakeshore Friends of Transit will speak to the Hudsonville City Council Tuesday about the need for public transportation in the city.

The committee is seeking approval of the addition of a ballot measure to 2012 election cycle. It will provide a recommendation for contracting with The Rapid for Monday through Saturday service in Hudsonville.

The friends of transit groups are asking for people who live or work in Hudsonville to speak to the council in support of the recommendation. The meeting is 7 p.m. at the Hudsonville City Hall.

The Macatawa Area Express Transit Authority is supporting the recommendation as a regional effort by MAX and other providers to create links between communities and transit systems, a MAX statement said.
