Talk on housing issues for people with disabilities in Ottawa County

OTTAWA COUNTY -- The Disability Network will host two meetings to gather community input on housing issues in West Michigan.

Topics to be discussed include affordability, accessibility to housing and access to public amenities for people with disabilities.

The first meeting is at 6:30 p.m. Aug. 18 at Herrick District Library, 300 S. River Ave. in Holland. The second meeting is at 6:30 p.m. Aug. 20 at the Allendale Township Library, 6175 Library Lane.

The sessions are part of a yearlong survey with housing organizations, people with disabilities and others concerned about housing issues.

The results will help develop housing solutions to be shared with local leaders.
